#### **Trafficking & Smuggling**

- What is TRAFFICKING (involuntary)-Part 5 Imm. Act 2003
  - In Person;
  - Recruitment, transportation, transfer, habouring or receipt ...for exploitation (*Part 5, s17(c)-Immigration Act 2003*.
  - Trafficked person; subject to trafficking in persons
- What is SMUGGLING (voluntary)- Part 5 Imm. Act 2003
  - Arranging or assisting of an unauthorised migrant's illegal entry into any country (*Part 5,s17(c*)-Immigration Act 2003.





## Difference - Trafficking and Smuggling

- Exploitation
- **Smuggling** ends with the arrival of the migrants at their destination,
- whereas
- Trafficking involves the ongoing exploitation of the victims in some manner to generate illicit profits for the traffickers
